Transactions: Inbound

Pallets are no longer showing available once they are in use.

Pallets assigned to store items were mistakenly showing as still available.

Transactions: Outbound

For items stored in multiple locations, Pick Tickets were duplicating the Quantity Request.

Notice in the image below that each Item to be pulled is stored in multiple locations. When generated, the Pick Ticket was duplicating Quantity Requests as shown by Item 38-0028 and AB3003 being listed twice. This has been fixed and items to be pulled will only list once on Pick Tickets.

Anniversary Date Invoicing

For Anniversary Date Invoicing, outbound transactions completed on the 31st day - for invoices for months that have 31 days - were not being included in that month's billing.

December has 31 days. If the Anniversary Date Invoicing date for is set to generate on 1/15 and the outbound transaction was dated 1/14, this transaction was not being included in the January invoice.

Anniversary Date Invoicing recognizes that some months have 30 days, and some have 31.
