Version 2024.25 MoversSuite

Revenue Entry

FEATURE

Option for addback based on Agent Percentage.

If you wish to base an addback item on the agent percentage of the revenue item, then there is new feature added in this release to do just that. An **Apply Agent Percentage to Add Back Item** flag is available within Reduction Template Setup that, when checked, evokes this feature.




Figure 1: Reduction Template Setup.

When this flag is set for a reduction, the application automatically calculates the add back item based on the Agent Percentage of the revenue item. The Agent Percentage is visible and can be updated within the Reductions screen.




Figure 2: Reductions screen.

The Agent Percentage defaults to what is set for the revenue item. It can be manually updated (enter a value between 0 and 100 and press Tab to save the setting). The application will update an existing add back item generated from the same reduction item, unless that add back item has accounting transactions generated for it.

Change Summary Agent Percentage setting added to the Reductions screen. Apply Agent Percentage to Add Back Item flag added to Reduction Template Setup that controls whether the Agent Percentage setting is available in Reductions. Two database tables were updated for this feature.

Atlas Integration

ENHANCEMENT

Previous Order logic now has feature switch.

Several Atlas agents wished to have an option to turn on a recently added feature that would update the Order Number in MoversSuite to match the latest order change in Atlas. The original feature was in rolled out in Version 2024.22 of MoversSuite. This feature was on by default, which means that if Atlas sent down a new Order Number, the order was updated in MoversSuite. With this release, this order update feature will only be on if a system value has been set on the Atlas system; this feature is off by default.

To turn on the Order Number update feature, the following XML System Option must be defined for the Atlas Van Lines interface within XML System Setup.




Figure 3: Add XML System Option dialog.

To create this XML System Option and enable the Order Number update for Atlas, follow these instructions:

- 1. From MoversSuite Administration > Administration > click to open XML System Setup.
- 2. Locate and open the Atlas interface record (which is typically titled, "AtlasSuds.")
- 3. Select Click here to add a new XML System Option."
- 4. Set Name to "UpdateFromPreviousOrder" and the Value to "True," as shown in Figure 3.
- 5. Save the XML System Option.
- 6. Save the XML System Setup record.
- 7. Users will need to restart MoversSuite to enable this setting.

When enabled, the functionality noted for "Previous Order" within the Atlas SUDS Order Download topic is turned on. Of note, the Order Number change only occurs if there is not revenue entered on the prior order (PREORD). In the case where an Atlas Order Number changes and revenue has been entered on the "PREORD," then the following happens:

- The "PREORD" order in MoversSuite keep the same order number.
- A new order will be created based on the new shipment coming in from Atlas.
- From the new order, the user can get to the "original" order by using the Related Order section > "Go To" button, located within Move Information.

Additional payment checks added to CSIPay requests.

In some cases, such as when a user attempts to process the same payment multiple times, an error is returned indicating "Unable to locate payment..." Additional checks have been added to verify where a payment is at in processing and allows for a "longer time out time" supported by CSIPay.

	Added AgentPercentage . The percentage referenced when an addback is based on the Agent Percentage to build an addback item. This setting for defined reductions is found within the <i>Add Back as Item Code</i> section within the Reductions screen. This column was added to apply an Agent Percentage to the addback created from a reduction. Refer to <i>Apply Agent Percentage to Add Back Item</i> flag description within Reduction Template Setup for more information. MOV-7278
ReductionTemplateHeader	Added IsAddbackBasedOnAgentPercentage. This column stores the flag set for the Apply Agent Percentage to Add Back Item setting with Reduction Template Setup. It instructs the application to evoke the Agent Percentage setting within the Add Back as Item Code section within the Reductions screen. Refer to Apply Agent Percentage to Add Back Item flag description within Reduction Template Setup for more information. MOV-7278

Version 2024.25 Known Issues

The following issues are problems that may affect your decision to upgrade to this version of MoversSuite. The following issues are not resolved for this release.

QuickBooks Support for IE11 Deprecating for Authorization Screens (September 8, 2020)

Due to security requirements, starting Sept. 8, 2020, only Chromium-based embedded browsers will be supported for **QuickBooks Online Connection Authorization** screens and Internet Explorer 11-based embedded browsers will no longer work.

For authorization process in MoversSuite, the previous two versions of Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox, Microsoft Edge, and Safari (11+) are supported. This is for the users who first turn the QuickBooks feature on. Or, in case, the feature is being used after a long while. Refer to this blog for further details on changes made.

Supported Windows Themes

Related to the scaling issue (listed below), MoversSuite recommends that if your client server is on Windows 10, that you avoid using themes developed for earlier versions of Windows. In other words, please load and use themes developed for the current version of Windows that you are on.

NOTE: The Aero theme works well with Windows Server 2008 R2. Reference the following video as a guide to installing the theme service and theme itself:

Screen scaling not available with MoversSuite

With the advances in screen size and resolution, many underlying applications are not able to deal with all the variations in configurations available to the variety of high definition (HD) screens, such as not being able to read field labels, etc. Due to this limitation, MoversSuite cannot scale as desired in all situations. **UPDATE:** With the release of MoversSuite 2018 R15, a solution has been implemented to address many of the issues involving scaling. (3705, 4114)

Until there is a better solution to scaling, EWS Group recommends that if you experience scaling problems with the MoversSuite application keep the size of your application to 100% and change the resolution as desired. On Windows machines, you can verify and/or update the display settings as follows:

- 1. Right-click somewhere on your desktop and select Display Settings
- 2. Set the Change the size of text, apps, and other items to 100%.
- 3. Click on Apply to save the changes.
- 4. Click on Advanced display settings.
- **5.** Make changes to the **Resolution** as needed.
- **6.** Click on **Apply** to save the changes.
- 7. Close the screen by pressing the X in the upper right-hand corner of the screen.
